

Call for papers for the scientific journal Thesaurismata

Inaugurating its new publishing year, the Hellenic Institute of Byzantine and Post-Byzantine Studies in Venice invites those interested to submit their works for publication in the new volume of the scientific journal ***Thesaurismata***.

The writers must present an original study that has not been published yet or submitted for publication in any other printed or electronic edition, in whole or in part, in Greece or abroad. They are to be previously evaluated for their scientific competence by members of the Editorial Committee specialized in the scientific field in which each paper is included (peer review), as well as for whether they regard byzantine or post-byzantine topics and have followed the specific **Publishing Regulations**.

The articles chosen to be finally published will be sent to the authors for correction by the editor of the volume only twice: before and after the lay-out/pagination of the volume. After the publication, each author receives a printed and electronic offprint.

As far as the extent of the articles, the number of pages is not limited in principle. However, the texts must be clear and concise in size.

Papers are accepted in Greek, English, Italian and French and must be accompanied by a summary of up to 300 words in a language selected from the above mentioned.

The authors are responsible for obtaining permission to republish their works or parts of it, in accordance with Greek copyright law. The right of republishing should be mentioned in the new edition of their text, as well as its first edition in the *Thesaurismata*.
